Carla had a good weekend in Tanzania with the AIM women who came for a get-away and spiritual nurture from the book of Proverbs. The study she did in preparation was really a treat, but also found those proverbs are quite challenging to live out! If only we did what it said, how much better off we'd all be.

Lanny had a variety of meetings, informal and formal, during our times in Kenya, including Association of Evangelicals in Africa and RVA school board. AIM's aviation program is currently on alert for possible evacuations of personnel from other organizations working in Sudan, where the border is being contested between the north and south—please keep praying for the situation there as we approach July 9th and the date the new country is to become official.

We spent a week at the admin base for the TIMO program, AIM's two year church planting and missionary training program. Among other things, Carla had the opportunity to teach on trust and forgiveness on teams, and Lanny led an exercise on cultural values and how clashes in value create conflict. It was good to be with 5 future TIMO team leaders—4 of them from other organizations and all of those African (Tanzanian, Kenyan, South African and Malagasy).
